

# Book Bag Program

Your child will soon begin a nightly reading program. First, I assess your second grader with benchmark books to determine their instructional reading level. Your child will bring one or two books home to practice reading. As your child develops better reading strategies and fluency, the level of difficulty increases.



It is my goal to have your child reading AT or ABOVE grade level by the end of 2nd grade. To accomplish this goal, it is VITAL that you LISTEN to your child read at least 15 minutes per night. I will provide the books.

Our class has a variety of books thanks to the support of parents from previous classes.

We also collect pop cans to raise money to purchase new and replace worn books. Thank you in advance for your support.

Working together will help our children become better readers.
